- **Many families use DTS hours to cover summer programs for their children. This is a wonderful option we want to make sure our RSK families know about so let's go over some DTS facts.
- -DTS stands for "Day Treatment & Training Summer" Program and they are hours you can request from your child's support coordinator to cover day programs or summer programs from DDD providers.

- -What is the purpose of DTS hours? Day Treatment and Training Services (Day Programs) provide training, supervision, and activities to a member to develop skills. This service is primarily offered in a community setting. It is intended to help members learn safety skills and socialize. The main focus of DTS is skill building in a group setting with an emphasis on recreation, leisure and socialization. Functional goals for the DTS hours will be created by the child's support coordinator and parent or guardian.
- -How many hours of DTS summer can be billed per day? A max of 4 DTS hours can be billed per day. Hours do not roll over to compensate for missed days.
- -How are the children supervised in the DTS settings? All children are given a 1-4 ratio (one adult to four children) but an enhanced ratio can be assessed for children with physical, behavioral or medical issues. Approval from DDD is needed before we can provide services to your child.
